

## Infor POS Updates Effective Friday February 27 for Penny Rounding in US

**Note: This information applies to US accounts using Infor POS (formerly known as Vivonet) point of sale systems**

To support Sodexo's new procedures supporting penny-free transactions, Infor POS will update all terminals at US accounts on February 27, implementing automatic rounding of cash transactions. This enhancement will make future penny-free transactions easier for cashiers and customers.

When the cashier selects the cash tender key, the POS will automatically **round down** the total to the nearest nickel (.00 or .05). To view a sample transaction, please view [INFOR POS Penny Rounding Functionality - Sample Cash Transaction video](#).

Transactions with non-cash payments will not change (they will not be rounded). Also, there is no impact if your account is 100% cashless.

Infor Enterprise Manager 3 will report the total amount rounded in the **Operations Report Tender Summary** as **Rounding** (Dynamic Reporting). Please see example below:

There will be no change with daily cash sales reporting in UFS. Any shortage attributed to the rounding will post to the unit's short account but should remain within the Over/Short Transmission threshold. If you report a shortage and the penny-rounding impact exceeds \$0.99, please use **Over/Short Reason Code 2: Customer Change Dispute**. If the primary cause of the shortage is something other than penny rounding, select the Over/Short reason code that best reflects the true cause.

If your account deposits cash with the client (i.e. Client Cash or Client Banking) and your client prefers to round to the nearest nickel (up or down), then please contact the INFOR Post-Deployment team ([EnterprisePOS-Support.Noram@Sodexo.com](mailto:EnterprisePOS-Support.Noram@Sodexo.com)) to align with your client's preferences.

**Penny Rounding Set to Go Live on All INFOR POS Terminals**

\*If your site is 100% cashless on your INFOR POS, this message will not apply to you.
